Our response

Identifying the issues involved with the Port Sorell Landfill and township contamination and then clear and concise messaging was crucial to communicating with local residents.

Openness and honesty in two way communications was also vital. To achieve this the communications team door-knocked every residence in the vicinity of the landfill. The meetings with residents were conducted in a very cordial manner that explained the risks and issues in plain, easy to understand English.

The team also held card-table discussions at the local shopping centre on Saturday mornings.

Gathering data from the residents was vital and it was entered into our proprietary communications database for analysis.
